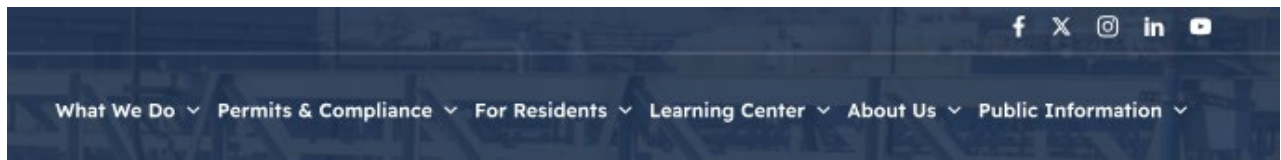

1 PRIVATE SERVICE LATERALS
Home and business owners are responsible for maintaining their own private sewer lines leading to their manholes.

HOME

BUSINESS
Reduced Odor Trap or Interceptor
Cleaned

2 LOCAL SEWER LINE
Locality or agencies are responsible for maintaining local sewer (except your neighborhood).

3 REGIONAL TRUNKLINE SEWER
Orange County Sanitation District is responsible for collecting, treating and recycling wastewater at a regional level.

4 STORM DRAIN
Stormwater and other runoff enter stormwater drains sewer systems from streets, curbs and gutters and flow into separate local water bodies or the Pacific Ocean.
