
# Wall and Soil Improvements Project

#### **Project Information**

The Wall and Soil Improvements (Wall) project will replace the perimeter chain link fence with a concrete wall and make soil improvements at the southern end of OC San Plant No. 2 located along the Talbert Marsh in Huntington Beach. This project will provide added site security and climate resiliency.

#### **Project Need**

OC San Plant No. 2 falls under Homeland Security guidelines for critical infrastructure. The existing chain link fence is not sufficient to provide the site security required. The new wall height ranges between 8 and 11 feet and will provide site security, visual screening of the process facilities, protection from future sea level flood protection, and withstand tsunami forces. Soil improvements will mitigate concerns of lateral spread by keeping structures in place, so they do not shift during a seismic event.
