



Buena Park Sewer Improvements

Project Information

The project will make improvements to the regional sewer pipelines in the City of Buena Park, with a small portion of work extending into the City of La Palma. The project will rehabilitate just under a mile of pipeline and over 40 existing manholes. In addition, the project will construct new manholes and other improvements to the sewer system.

To keep sewer service uninterrupted, temporary pumps and piping will be used to reroute flows during construction. Work will take place in sections of Beach Boulevard, Kingman Avenue,

Artesia Boulevard, Knott Avenue, Caballero Boulevard, and Valley View Street.

Project Need

OC San is committed to protecting public health and the environment by keeping the sewer system in good condition. Originally constructed under various projects between 1959 and 1998, pipeline and manhole inspections show areas with cracks and deterioration. This project will make repairs and upgrades to the pipeline and manholes to extend their life to continue providing reliable sewer service for the community.
